SUBJECT: CASCOM Acquisition Management Oversight Contracting Workload Prioritization Program Policy

- 1. PURPOSE: To designate the US Army Combined Arms Support Command (CASCOM) G8 as the priority contract workload designator for CASCOM contracts with the CASCOM Mission Installation Contracting Command (MICC).
- 2. Background: Given the fact that the MICC has limited workload capacity, I want to ensure that they are always working the highest priority CASCOM contract actions. There are many variables that go into this prioritization. These include: the CG approved 1-n list; mission synchronization considerations; available funding and allotment; timing of the Period of Performance; timing of Continuing Resolutions; budget execution goals; and others.
- 3. Effective immediately, workload prioritization for all CASOM contracting requirements already in the MICC will be determined by CASCOM G8. In his absence, the Comptroller or Budget officer will assume this role. The MICC will refer customers with prioritization issues to the CASCOM G8. Schools can request adjustments of priorities thru the DtCG.
- 4. This policy is effective until superseded or rescinded.
