SUBJECT: United States Army Combined Arms Support Command and Fort Lee Risk Decision Policy

- 1. References:
 - a. AR 385-10, Army Safety Program, 24 February 2017.
 - b. DA Pam 385-30, Risk Management, 2 February 2014.
- 2. Risk management is our most effective tool to protect the force by providing a systematic framework for identifying and controlling risks in all environments and operations. Commanders are responsible for managing risk to ensure potential benefit outweighs the potential loss.
- 3. Risk decisions will be based on the residual risk of an activity after applying appropriate control measures. Risk decision authority is as follows:
- a. Extremely High Risk Senior Commander and General Officer (GO) Commandants/Commanders.
- b. High Risk Commanders, Commandants or Leaders of separate organizations (Colonel/O-6) or equivalent in the appropriate Chain of Command.
- c. Moderate Risk Lieutenant Colonels (Battalion Commanders/Department Directors) or equivalent in the appropriate Chain of Command.
- d. Low Risk Company Commanders or Division Chiefs or equivalent in the appropriate Chain of Command.
- 5. This policy supersedes Risk Decision Policy dated 11 September 2017.
- 6. This policy is effective until superseded or rescinded.
