SUBJECT: Sexual Assault Prevention - Commercial Lodging Prohibition for Initial Entry Training (IET) Soldiers

1. Reference. TRADOC Regulation 350-6, Enlisted Initial Entry Training Policies and Administration, 30 January 2018.

2. Purpose. To deter sexual assaults and other sexual misconduct among IET Soldiers.

3. Policy:

a. I am concerned about the potential for sexual assaults and other sexual misconduct to be committed in commercial lodging establishments among IET Soldiers in a pass status. Commercial lodging includes any hotel, motel, bed and breakfast, or other facility engaged providing shelter for profit, located on or off any military installation.

b. IET Soldiers are prohibited from renting, visiting, entering, or staying in any commercial lodging room while in a pass status without prior written approval of the first O-6 in the Soldier's chain of command. Prior to granting such approval, Commanders will require Soldiers requesting an exception to this policy to provide a list of individuals who will be allowed in the commercial lodging room and the Soldier's purpose for renting, staying in, or visiting the commercial lodging room.

c. This policy applies to all IET Soldiers that meet the definition of "trainee" in TRADOC Reg. 350-6, Glossary, Section II, including but not limited to Soldiers undergoing reclassification training and those in a hold status. This policy does not apply to IET Soldiers in a leave or TDY status.


d. This is a punitive policy. Violations of this policy by Soldiers may result in adverse administrative action or punishment under Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice.

4. This policy letter is effective until superseded or rescinded.
