

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Sexual Assault Prevention and Off-Post Lodging

1. Reference. TRADOC Regulation 350-6, Enlisted Initial Entry Training Policies and Administration, 7 November 2013.
2. Purpose. To deter sexual assaults and other inappropriate sexual conduct among Initial Entry Training (IET) Soldiers.
3. Policy:
  - a. I am concerned about the potential for sexual assaults and other sexual misconduct to be committed in off-post lodging establishments among IET Soldiers in a pass status.
  - b. IET Soldiers are prohibited from renting, visiting, or staying in any off-post lodging room while in a pass status without prior written approval of the first O-6 in the Soldier's chain of command. Prior to granting such approval, commanders will require Soldiers requesting an exception to this policy to provide a list of individuals who will be allowed in the room and the Soldier's purpose for renting, staying in, or visiting the room.
  - c. This policy applies to all IET Soldiers that meet the definition of "trainee" in TRADOC Reg. 350-6, Glossary, Section II, including but not limited to Soldiers undergoing reclassification training and those in a hold status. This policy does not apply to IET Soldiers in a leave or TDY status.
  - d. This is a punitive policy. Violations of this policy by Soldiers may result in adverse administrative action or punishment under Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice.
4. Proponent. The proponent for this policy is the Office of the Staff Judge Advocate.
