
2. Purpose. To delegate authority to approve Recruitment, Relocation, and Retention (3R's) appropriated funds for civilian employees within the Combined Arms Support Command (CASCOM).

3. Scope. This delegation applies to the consideration and approval of all 3R's incentives for civilian employees working for CASCOM.

4. Delegation. The approval authority for CASCOM is delegated to the lowest General Officer/Senior Executive level within the organization. This delegation is effective immediately and may not be further delegated.

5. Policy. Consideration and approval of the 3R's will be in accordance with a, b, and c above. All recommendations for approval should be routed through G1 for final recommendation.
