MEMORANDUM FOR Headquarters and Headquarters Company (HHC), United States Army Combined Arms Support Command (CASCOM)

SUBJECT: Company Command Policy Letter 18-3 – Prohibited Relationships

## 1. REFRENCES:

- a. TRADOC Regulation (TR) 350-6 (Enlisted Initial Entry Training Policies and Administration), 30 January 2018
  - b. Army Regulation AR 600-20 (Army Command Policy), 6 November 2014
- 2. The following relationships are forbidden:
- a. Permanent party and Advanced Individual Training (AIT): Any actual or attempted personal or social relationship between any CASCOM personnel and any AIT Soldier on or off the installation.
- b. Fraternization: Army policy defines fraternization as any relationship between Soldiers of different rank in which the relationship appears to compromise authority, discipline and morale of the unit.
- 3. Authorized activities: All personnel, regardless of rank, are authorized to participate in unit or section social activities, post wide and school functions, and organized sporting events on an individual or team basis as long as these activities are properly supervised and conducted in an orderly and professional manner. However, HHC CASCOM permanent party personnel are not authorized to invite or interact with AIT Soldiers during the above events as outlined in the definition of Fraternization.
- 4. All Soldiers must remember that as a member of CASCOM, we often work side by side with senior NCOs and Officers. Traditional military customs and courtesies are always required
- 5. Reporting procedures: Report all suspected violations of this policy to section supervisors, the First Sergeant, or Company Commander.
- 6. This policy is in effect until superseded or rescinded.
